

## Andrew Foodbank

According to the most recent figure provided by the Ministry of Interior of Taiwan, the number of low-income households who rely on economic support from the government has exceeded 260,000. Children from these households hardly have sufficient food supply and their body development is severely hindered based on the same reason. They are not only the victims of malnutrition but poverty as well – not to mention the deprivation of family support and the social problems it may imply.



In response to this dilemma, Andrew Charity Association of R.O.C. has established the Andrew Food Bank, distributing food and goods to children living in poverty ranging from age 0 to 15. We monthly provide these children with food packages containing rice, noodles, powdered milk, cereal, porridge, seasoning, biscuits, and children books. Our network plays an essential role in delivering these packages to those in urgent needs.

Under the conviction of “They shall not starve!” Andrew Charity Association of R.O.C. works to end hunger of children living in poverty and helps them to achieve greater dignity and independence.
